

## **LIBA INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS – An Overview**

In today's fast changing world where globalization and privatization are part of everyday lingua franca, LIBA strives to expose and prepare its students for the global arena. In that context, LIBA has many international exchange/collaborative programs with institutions located in Asia, Europe and USA. These programs offer students an opportunity to take classes in foreign institutions, to interact with foreign students visiting LIBA and to attend classes taught by faculty from abroad. Likewise, faculty from LIBA pursue joint research and teaching activities with their counterparts in the partnering institutions. These programs expose the students to new countries and new cultures.

A list of the institutions with which LIBA has / had exchange programmes are given below (in alphabetical order).

### **1. Assumption University, Thailand, [www.au.edu](http://www.au.edu)**

Assumption University has the distinction of being considered the most respected International University in Thailand. The most recent Memorandum Of Understanding that LIBA and Assumption University of Thailand signed on 30-01-2018 aims to bring together the students and faculty of the two institutions. Student exchanges, Faculty exchanges, Joint conferences, research programs and other forms of academic interactions are proposed.

Rated as a 5 Star (Excellent) University by the Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) MALAYSIA, Binary University is one of the most established and respected universities for management, IT and entrepreneurship education in Asia. The University offers superior programmes at PhD, Masters and Bachelors level that are internationally recognized by the Association of Commonwealth Universities (ACU, UK), International Association of Universities (IAU, France), NARIC (UK) and the Malaysian Qualification Authority (MQA). The University also places great emphasis on research and has dedicated research centers in social entrepreneurship, ICT centre of excellence, women leadership, business entrepreneurship and advanced management.



## 3. Fordham University, U.S.A., <https://www.fordham.edu/>


The **Gabelli School of Business** is the undergraduate and graduate business schools of [Fordham University](https://www.fordham.edu/), the Jesuit University of New York. Fordham University's involvement in business started early in the 20th century with the founding of the School of Business in 1920. The Gabelli School of Business has been an [AACSB](#)-accredited business school for over 50 years and is a partner with the [CFA Institute](#).

The Gabelli School of Business was established in 1920 in the [Financial District](#) of [Lower Manhattan](#), and is now located on Fordham's Rose Hill campus in the [Bronx](#) as well as on the Lincoln Center campus in [Manhattan](#). Fordham established itself as a provider of graduate business education in 1969, with the launch of its first master's degree programs at the Lincoln Center campus. The Graduate School of Business opened in 1969 as part of the redevelopment of [Lincoln Center](#). The Graduate School of Business was part of a consortium offering an MBA at Peking University in Beijing China from 1998-2008 and was replaced by Vlerick University. This program, known as BiMBA (Beijing international MBA), was listed by Forbes Magazine as one of the most valuable Chinese programs.

The Agreement between LIBA And ICHEC signed on 18<sup>th</sup> October 2007 aims to enrich and advance the academic programs through exchange of faculty, researchers and students as well as implementation of joint training, seminars, research and development activities.



**5. Institute d'Economie Scientifique et de Gestion (IESEG) School of Management, France, <https://www.ieseg.fr/>**

IESEG is a member of the Lille Catholic University, the largest private university in France, It was established in 1964 and has triple accreditations EQUIS, AMBA, and the AACSB. It has two campuses – Lille and Paris in France. A Faculty and Student Exchange Agreement was signed on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2005.



**6. Instituto Tecnológico Y De Estudios Superiores De Occidente (ITESO), Mexico,**

ITESO is the Jesuit University of Guadalajara. Founded in 1957, it belongs to the group of Jesuit universities in the world. ITESO is the first university in Jalisco to be listed as an Institution of Academic Excellence by the Mexican Ministry of Public Education. This means that, in order to offer you the best tools for your academic performance, we constantly update our academic programs, as well as our academic and technological infrastructure.

ITESO's educational mission is to educate free, intelligent, and sensitive individuals who are committed to their society and determined to meet the needs of their communities.

An MOU was signed between LIBA and ITESO on 30 September 2005. The general purpose of the Agreement is to establish specific educational relations and co-operations between the two participating institutions in order to promote academic linkages and to enrich the understanding of the culture of the two countries concerned.

Santa Clara University is a private non-profit Jesuit university located in Santa Clara, California. It has about 5,400 full-time undergraduate students, and 3,300 graduate students. LIBA is collaborating with the center for Social Entrepreneurship at Santa Clara University since August 2011.



**8. Katholische Universität Eichstatt-Ingolstadt (KU), Germany,**

KU, the only Roman Catholic University is also biggest private university in Germany. It has around 4800 students. Its small size offers ideal ambience for teaching and learning. The Faculty of Business at Ingolstadt is one of the most competitive business schools in Germany. An Agreement of Cooperation was signed on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2007 with LIBA.



**9. Katholieke Universiteit Leuven (CEE-KUL), Belgium,**

KU Leuven, founded in 1425 by Pope Martin V, has the double distinction of being the oldest existing Catholic university in the world. At present, it caters to more than 31000 students, approximately 12% of whom are international students from more than 120 nations. MOU signed on 7<sup>th</sup> February 2007.

The Bordeaux School of Management in France founded in 1874 is ranked among the top business schools in the world. It has triple accreditations EQUIS, AMBA, and the AACSB. It

has two campuses - Bordeaux & Marseille in France. An MOU was signed on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2015 with LIBA.

Le Moyne College, has a picturesque 160-acre campus located in Syracuse, New York. It offers more than 700 courses leading to Bachelor of Art or Bachelor of Science degrees in over 30 different majors. Le Moyne also provides courses of study leading to a Master's in business administration, education, nursing and physician assistant studies. It has an enrollment of approximately 2800 undergraduate students and 600 graduate students.

It is one of the leading business schools and has three campuses in Paris, Reims and Rouen. It has triple accreditations EQUIS, AMBA, and the AACSB. An MOU was signed in September 2009 with LIBA.

Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, known as UCSC or UNICATT, is an Italian private research university founded in 1921. Cattolica is the largest private university in Europe and the largest Catholic University in the world. A Memorandum of Understanding was signed in January 2007 with LIBA.

Universidad Loyola Andalucía is a [private university](#) seated in [Seville](#), [Spain](#), and with [campuses](#) in [Seville](#) and [Cordova](#), that was established for the 2013-14 academic year. It is a [Catholic university](#) run by the [Society of Jesus](#). The university originated in ETEA, the Faculty of Economic and Business Sciences of Córdoba, a higher education centre founded in 1963. The establishment of Loyola University Andalusia was approved by the [Parliament of Andalusia](#) on 23 November 2011. The first promotion enrolled in 2013. The university has two campuses: Campus Palmas Altas in [Seville](#) and Campus de Córdoba ETEA in [Córdoba](#). A Memorandum of Agreement was signed in November 2016 with LIBA.


**16. University of Antwerp (UA), Belgium,** <https://www.uantwerpen.be/en/>
